



1. The rules of racing adopted by the Iowa Racing and Gaming Commission and Prairie Meadows govern all races within Prairie Meadows. This stake is run with the understanding that associations reserve the right to refuse nomination without notice to the subscriber. No nomination will be received under this condition. All disputes, claims and objections arising out of the race or with respect to the interpretation of the conditions shall be decided by the association which they may appoint and their decision upon all points shall be final.
2. Prairie Meadows reserves the right to divide the races in any manner advisable with the total purse under these conditions to reduce the amount of guaranteed money, postpone, move or to cancel this stake at any time prior to the running thereof, without liability. Except nomination and entry fees in the cancellations.
3. Nominations are made with the understanding that said nomination does not assure stall space for horse nomination. Application must be approved by the Prairie Meadows stall committee. Eligible nominations and sustaining are limited by the time of actual receipt by the manager of the race. There will be no refund for any nomination, sustaining, or late payment.
5. All horses nominated must be registered and in good standing with the AQHA reported by AQHA will be used when determining the preference of horses based on their AQHA number.
6. The maximum number of starters in any race shall be limited to the starting positions afforded by the Prairie Meadows starting gates.
7. In nominating for the stake, subscriber assumed all risk of loss, damage or injury to persons, animals, or property used by subscriber on Prairie Meadows premises and releases Prairie Meadows from all such claims whether arising from negligence or otherwise.
8. Subscriber, through their agents and employees, hereby assigns to Prairie Meadows any and all right to television, radio and radio broadcasting in connection with this race.
9. Each time trial shall consist of no more than twelve (12) horses. The time trials shall be raced under these stake conditions. Trials are held on the same day, the ten (10) fastest times qualify to start in the finals. If time trials are held on two (2) days, horses with the ten (10) fastest times on the first trial day and the horses with the five (5) fastest times on the second day qualify to start in the finals. If twelve (12) or less enter into trials, Prairie Meadows reserves the right to cancel horses entered into trials will compete in finals. Purse to be distributed as stated below.
10. Horses qualify on the basis of time and/or order of finish in time trials. The finish times of horses in trial only on the date of the electric timing device. The sole exception to the preceding is when two (2) or more horses finish the same trial race, then order of finish shall also determine preference in qualifying for the finals.
11. Should two (2) or more trial horses have the same qualifying time (to the extent of the time) for the final to be conducted under the auspices of the Board of Stewards. Under no circumstances shall a horse qualify that was placed behind another horse, except due to disqualification.
12. During the running of trials, should a horse be disqualified due to interference, it shall receive the time of the horse placed behind plus one one-thousandth (0.001) of second or capacity of the Electric Timing Device.
13. No changes will be made in the recorded times of time trials to account for head, tail and cross winds, or reflection of the electric timing device. In the event of a malfunction during any time trial, finalist from that particular trial race will be by official hand timing. Hand timing will be conducted by no less than three (3) reputable and disinterested persons. The average of all times will be the winning times, unless one is clearly wrong, then the average time will be raised to the next lowest time.
14. The Net Purse will be paid pursuant to the Purse Distribution noted below and is equal to the total of nomination payments, late nomination payments, entry payments, and supplementary payments plus 5% of the total payments (excluding Added Monies, I.Q.H.R.A. Monies, and I.B.F. Supplement Monies) will be retained for administrative expenses or purposes.

If a horse is a finalist for a stake race that had nomination, sustaining and/or late supplemental payments and qualified through time trials, the horse shall remain on facility premises until the final. If a horse becomes a finalist for a stake race that does not run qualifying time trials, that horse must be stabled on facility premises by the date time trials are held on facility premises (and if the running of the final is delayed, the horse removed from facility premises or is not stabled on facility premises by the date time trials were scheduled to be held will be scratched from the final and will not be eligible for a refund of the fees paid or earn any purse monies from the final.

IRGC will perform hair testing on the ten (10) fastest qualifiers plus the eleven (11) fastest from time trials. In the event, there are no time trials necessary, the eleven (11) fastest from time trials will then report to the Test Barn or trainer/owner. Failure to report to the Test Barn will result in the horse automatically being scratched from the final. A negative hair test is received.
